*Snoqualmie Valley Hospital District is a public hospital district located in rural, eastern King County. The District is currently in the process of constructing a new replacement facility on a greenfield site. A variety of growth needs, restrictions on the old site, and changed transportation patterns drove the decision to relocate. To procure the new hospital, the District is working with a developer using a lease/lease back public/private partnership model. Starting fresh on a new site, the project was unconstrained by many of the factors that often shape a major hospital construction project, but at the same time, there has been an interesting tension between the ideas of the designers, the assumptions of the new codes adopted midway through the project, and the experiences of operating a critical access hospital in the community*

The success of the employee program allowed FHS to further partner with Carena to offer those services to patients as a seamless extension of urgent primary care services after regular clinic hours. As the integration of telemedicine services into physician practice continues to evolve, new opportunities continue to arise. Given the early results, it is clear that telemedicine will become an integral part of the primary care continuum in the future.*
